## AP CAPSTONE DIPLOMA PROGRAM

The AP Capstone Diploma Program is a two-year program based on two AP courses: AP Seminar and AP Research. Students who fulfill the requirements can earn academic awards recognized by colleges around the world. Students that take AP Seminar and AP Research and score a 3 or better receive a Capstone Certificate. Students who earn a 3 or higher on exams for AP Seminar and AP Research as well as 4 additional AP classes can earn the AP Capstone Diploma.
